Review Process

All papers were reviewed blindly (that is, with author information removed) by between 6 and 10 reviewers. The reviewers did not know the identity of the authors nor the authors of the reviewers. Reviewers were matched to papers based on a formula to minimize the distance between reviewers' stated expertise and interest and the topics covered in the paper. In cases where this formula did not provide at least 6 reviewers, reviewers were randomly assigned to papers. No reviewer was required to review more than 3 papers. The review process used the services of 222 reviewers from 56 countries. The reviewers are listed at the end of this book.

Reviewers were instructed to mentor the authors by providing feedback on how to improve the submission. They were further required to recommend whether or not the paper should be accepted using a six-point scale (from "reject" to "must accept").

Following the conclusion of the review process, reviewers of each paper were shown the reviews of other reviewers, as part of our process of mentoring reviewers to become better reviewers.

The authors of all papers, whether accepted or not, were provided with the reviewers' feedback, as part of our process of mentoring authors. Authors of accepted papers were asked to revise their submissions to address the issues raised in the reviews.

We believe that the papers in this book represent a great contribution to science.
